

# (Meet the) Flintstones

This very recognizable, well known theme song was written for the animated cartoon series *The Flintstones* which ran from 1960 to 1965. In the series it was played by a 22-piece big band orchestra. *The Flintstones* has been recorded by many groups, particularly in the jazz milieu.

**Performance notes:** The suggested tempo of  $\text{♩}=130$  is quite fast. Before attempting breakneck speeds you should learn to play the piece at a more sedate pace. Accordion registration is left to the player, but a bright tone (Violin or Oboe) will help to add some sparkle to the result. Keep the bass light by playing the notes with a staccato feel.
