Composed by Cole Porter for the 1948 Broadway musical Kiss Me Kate this song has been covered by countless musicians over the years. Featuring elegant melody and sophisticated harmonies, it has become one of Porter's most enduring and frequently performed songs.

Performance notes: This is a love song; play it like you mean it! There are some tricky bass patterns in this arrangement which you should master *before* you try to play with both hands together. Especially note the pattern changes at measures 37, 64 and 67.
