Agustín Lara is Mexico's most popular singer and composer of the early 20th century. His songs have been recorded by a diverse list of artists ranging from Bing Crosby to Errico Caruso. This song was originally featured in the 1941 Spanish language film "Melodías de América". In 1945 the Xavier Cugat Orchestra (with crooner Bing Crosby) took their version to #4 on the charts.

**Performance notes:** The **Bolero** originated in Cuba in the late 1800's (it is not related to the older Spanish Bolero which, confusingly, shares the same name). Play this song as a seductive dance in 4 with a firm beat. Pay particular attention to bass patterns which establish a firm foundation for the dancers.
