## The Speak Up Mambo

The Mambo is a Latin American dance developed in Cuba in the 1940s. In more recent it nes was developed into Salsa. Mambo was popularized in the 1950s by Pérez Prado. The composer Al Caster los, was a Cuban band leader who wrote and recorded for New York labels. This so g w s populated by the Manhattan Transfer in 1972.

**Performance notes:** Latin American dance numbers in the Rhumba, Salsa Mambo style all share strong beats on 1 and 3. The slurred bass chords starting at bar 32 are neant to in itate a vibrato, so don't release the button all the way (you may find it helpful to hold the bass button, alf-way in as well). There is a comma/breath-mark at the start of measure 47 indicating a very slight break ( sile c).
