This lovely and lonely song was written for the 1968 Beatles "White Album" where the lead guitar was played by George Harrison's good friend Eric Clapton.

Performance notes: Don't forget to honor the keychanges at measures 25 and 41 which toggle the key between A minor and A major. In measures 13, 21 and 45 we have used a ▲ to indicate quick bellows push/pull to emphasize notes (think of it as a bellows shake on a single note).
